- 6:17 pm Treasurer report
 - Showing PNL for 6/9 will run final numbers for year end 6/30, but doesn't expect many changes
 - Did much better than the conservative budget set for the year
 - Fundraising went well \$56.8k
 - Expenses were down (no chess, dance, etc.) \$14.5k
 - Net positive \$42.2k for the year

- Readathon brought in just under \$10k
- Expenses mainly consisted of classroom supplements (software/subscriptions) and teacher grants
- Bank balance of \$124.3k unrestricted / \$22.6k restricted
- Will start planning budget for next year over the summer more "normal"
 - Bringing back chess, dance, etc
- Also still waiting for money from spring school pictures
- Question regarding \$10k in restricted DL funds
 - Leftover from an old grant (funds were also granted to GE, etc)
 - Requires sign off from grantor to spend/move the funds
 - Has been used for training curriculum, etc

 - Reminder of Town Hall tomorrow morning will discuss plan for full time school in the fall
 - There will Open House events on July 7-8 from 9-11am to come in the building to see safety setups, etc
 - For the fall programs back in place for DL and GT (GT 1-5)
 - Teachers already have their class assignments
 - Submitted questions:
 - Will GT cohorts be combined with other groups at all (middle school model) - No
 - Will space/capacity be used as a reason to split/not reinstate GT? What is the cap? - More space will be found if needed. Classroom cap is 24 or 26 depending on the room
 - Will lack of staff be used as a reason to not reinstate GT / what happens if a teacher leaves? Will have the staff, GT teacher will be found if needed
 - Any plans for the middle school model? No
 - Will GT classes/teachers be fully supported? All programs will be fully supported

- Summer Rising participants will go to PS 75 site
- School Construction Authority currently starting 8-12 month planning phase
 - Looking at roof repairs and also exterior planning to start fall 2022, take roughly 2 years to complete
 - Will keep everyone updated with procedures and timing as it develops
- Ongoing communication will hold a Town Hall in August with more details about the fall
- Questions from chat:
 - School hours for the fall? 8:30 am 2:50 pm
 - Could construction take place full time in the summer? Still in preliminary planning phase
 - Currently no plans for early drop off in the fall
- Christine Loughlin on construction she meets with SCA multiple times throughout the year
 - Work is accelerated during summer months
 - Will work with Mr. Lopez
- Wild Arts will be back in the fall (Therese is on the board)
 - Email to come with updated information and fees
 - There was a concern about permit fees
 - This past year various fees went up related to cleaning and overtime - expected to go down next school year, in part due to stimulus money

 - Attendance can be checked online and is updated
 - Funds trying to spend some money before year end or would revert back to DOE
 - Had to be used this year within specific parameters, about \$40k will go back
