## **5:08 PM - Call to Order and Introductions**

- **Greetings**
  - Members discussed how they celebrate Christmas/ Hannukah/ Kwanza/ Chinese New Year, and their plans for the holiday break
- **CEP**
  - Current CEP groups were identified (math, ELA, absenteeism, quality IEP, supportive environment), all groups focus on students with disabilities
  - New SLT members volunteered to join one of the CEP groups
  - CEP goals of all the groups (decided on last year) were shared
  - CEP groups discussed the specific goals of that group and how they can help reach those goals (10 min), discussion comments were added to a google form
